

Case study on Disabilities of the IDO project areas

Integrated Development Organization (IDO) is a non-government organization which has legal status of the country. From its inception the organization emphasizes the human rights with disabilities. In this context, the organization has a shelter home cum training centre where the disable persons are sheltered and trained up. The organization has taken initiative to perform a positive role with disabilities and prepares 15 case study of the disables who are the inhabitant of the IDO Project areas where they live in miseries and the burden of the family. The case study on 15 disable are shown in bellow:

Case Study No-1

Goutom Das is disabled from his born and cannot walk, cannot speak, and passing days in miseries situation, with two disabled children. His father maintains the family through working on bamboo and canes in a sorrowful condition. His monthly income average BDT.1, 200.00, which is very insufficient for the family of 7 members. He has one 30 decimals of land with house land. His mother is a housewife. Goutom Das is the second out of 5 children. So, his parents cannot help Goutom Das, because, they are living under severe poverty.

He has one 30 decimals of land with house land. His mother is a housewife. Uttom Das is the first out of 5 children. So, his parents cannot help Uttom Das, because, they are living under severe poverty.

His monthly income average BDT.1,100.00, which is very insufficient for the family of 3 members. He has one 05 decimals of land with house land. His mother is a housewife. Akash Babu is the only child. So, his parents cannot help him, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled children.

His monthly income average BDT.1,000.00, which is very insufficient for the family of 5 members. His mother is a maidservant and works other's family. His father married other women and live separate and does not help Jahangir. So, his mother cannot help him, because, she is living under severe poverty with the disabled child and other two children.

Her father has one 11 decimals of land with house land. Her mother is a housewife. Rupa is the only child of the disabled father and mother. So, her parents cannot help him, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled child and disabled father.

He is the eldest son of his parents among 3 children. His mother is a housewife. So, his parents cannot help him for treatment, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled children with small income.

So, his parents cannot help him for treatment and other purposes, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled children with small income.

His monthly income average BDT.1,200.00, which is not insufficient to main the family of 8 members. His father has 12 decimals of land with house land. He is the fourth son of his parents among 6 children. His mother is a housewife. So, his parents cannot help him for treatment and other purposes, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled children with small income.

So, his parents cannot help him for treatment and other purposes, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled children with small income.

So, her mother cannot help him for treatment and other purposes, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled girl with small income.

She is the eldest daughter of her mother among 3 children. So, her parents cannot help him for treatment and other purposes, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled girl with small income.

So, her parents cannot help him for treatment and other purposes, because, they are living under severe poverty with the disabled girl with small income.
